VIETNAM-SPECIFIC SCHEDULE

1. SCOPE OF APPLICATION:

- a. As a Data Controller and Processor, where Datalogic is supplied the Personal Data of a Vietnamese Citizen, this Vietnam-Specific Schedule (the "**Schedule**") and PDP Regulations of Vietnam will apply to such processing and shall be deemed to be an integral part of the Privacy Statement and Cookie Policy Version 4.0 (September, 2023) (the "**Policy**") to the same extent as if it had been set out in full within the Policy.
- b. To clarify, PDP Regulations of Vietnam means Vietnamese laws and regulations of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam on the Protection of Personal Data, including but not limited to Decree No. 13/2023/ND-CP on the Protection of Personal Data taking effect on 01 July 2023 and its guiding statutory instruments thereafter.
- c. In the event that any of the provisions in this Schedule conflicts with any of the provisions of the Policy, then to the extent of such conflict this Schedule will prevail, as long as the conflict refers to the Processing of Vietnamese Citizen's Personal Data.
- d. All terms which are capitalized but not defined in this Schedule shall have the same meaning as per the definition in the Policy.

2. DATA PROCESSING:

a. **Prior Notice and Valid Consent:**

- (i) Whenever you address the Site, you will be provided with the Policy and this Schedule as a clear and conspicuous notice regarding the processing of your Personal Data. Additionally, by agreeing to continue using the Service, your valid consent will be obtained prior to Datalogic processing your Personal Data for the Purpose of data processing as required by PDP Regulations of Vietnam.
- (ii) In case Datalogic processes your sensitive Personal Data (as defined by the PDP Regulations of Vietnam), Datalogic shall strictly comply with all applicable provisions of the PDP Regulations of Vietnam. This includes but not limited to providing you with a notice informing you that your sensitive Personal Data is being collected and processed.
- (iii) Datalogic shall not knowingly process any Personal Data of a child (person under the age of 16) without first verifying the child's age and obtaining verifiable prior valid consent from the child's parent or legal guardian. Additionally, if the child is at least seven (07) years old, Datalogic will also obtain the child's consent.

- b. **Withdrawal of Consent:** The withdrawal of your valid consent to rectify or erase your Personal Data shall have no bearing on the lawfulness of the processing activities that

occurred prior to your withdrawal, provided such consent was valid at the time of processing.

- c. During your data processing, we will take appropriate protective measures as required by the PDP Regulations of Vietnam, including, carrying out personal data protection impact assessments, obtaining necessary approval from the competent authorities, if necessary.

3. TRANSFER AND SHARE PERSONAL DATA TO PROCESSORS, THIRD PARTIES:

- a. In principle, your Personal Data that is collected by Datalogic and be stored in Italy. However, your Personal Data may be required to be stored in Vietnam and disclosed to a competent Vietnamese authority upon a lawful request in connection with its regulatory functions.
- b. For the avoidance of doubt, and except as otherwise permitted or required by the PDP Regulations of Vietnam, any transfer or sharing of your Personal Data as described above has been prior notification to you and the obtaining of your valid consent in accordance with the PDP Regulations of Vietnam and in a manner consistent with the Section 2 of this Schedule and the Policy.
